

EU referendum results for Warrington, June 2016

A referendum on Britain's membership in the EU was held on Thursday 23 June 2016. The question asked was: "Should the United Kingdom remain a member of the European Union or leave the European Union?"

The number of votes cast in favour of REMAIN was:	52, 657
The number of votes cast in favour of LEAVE was:	62,487
