Domestic Homicide Review: Mrs Clare MUNRO

Thank you for submitting the Domestic Homicide Review report for Warrington to the Home Office Quality Assurance (QA) Panel. The report was considered at the QA Panel meeting on 21 March 2017.

The QA Panel would like to thank you for conducting a joint review and for providing them with the final report. The Panel concluded this was a well written, thorough report which has been significantly enhanced by the contribution of family and friends. Good lessons have been clearly drawn out in the report together with examples of good practice.

There were some other aspects of the report which the Panel felt could be revised which you will wish to consider:

- Please proof read as there are typing errors. For example in paragraph 5.5.12 in the overview report and paragraphs 3.3.4, 3.4.2, 3.5.2 and 3.7.4 in the executive summary;
- It would be helpful if the status column in the action plan could contain consistent colours and an explanation provided of what the blue rating means.

The Panel does not need to review another version of the report.

I refer to the letter from the previous Chair of the Partnership dated 13 October which set out compelling reasons for producing a redacted report. I can confirm that the QA Panel agrees with this approach.

The QA Panel felt it would be helpful to routinely sight Police and Crime Commissioners on DHRs in their local area. I am, accordingly, copying this letter to your PCC for information.
