
THE WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL (BURFIELD DRIVE, APPLETON)

The **WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL** ("the Authority") did on 26th February 1974 make the above Tree Preservation Order ("the Order") pursuant to Section 60 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 ("the Act") the Order being subsequently confirmed by the Authority with modifications on 6th April 1976.

The Authority now hereby varies the Order pursuant to Section 198 and Section 201 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") as shown in Schedule 1 which shall now be designated as the Warrington Borough Council (Burfield Drive, Appleton) Tree Preservation Order 2000.

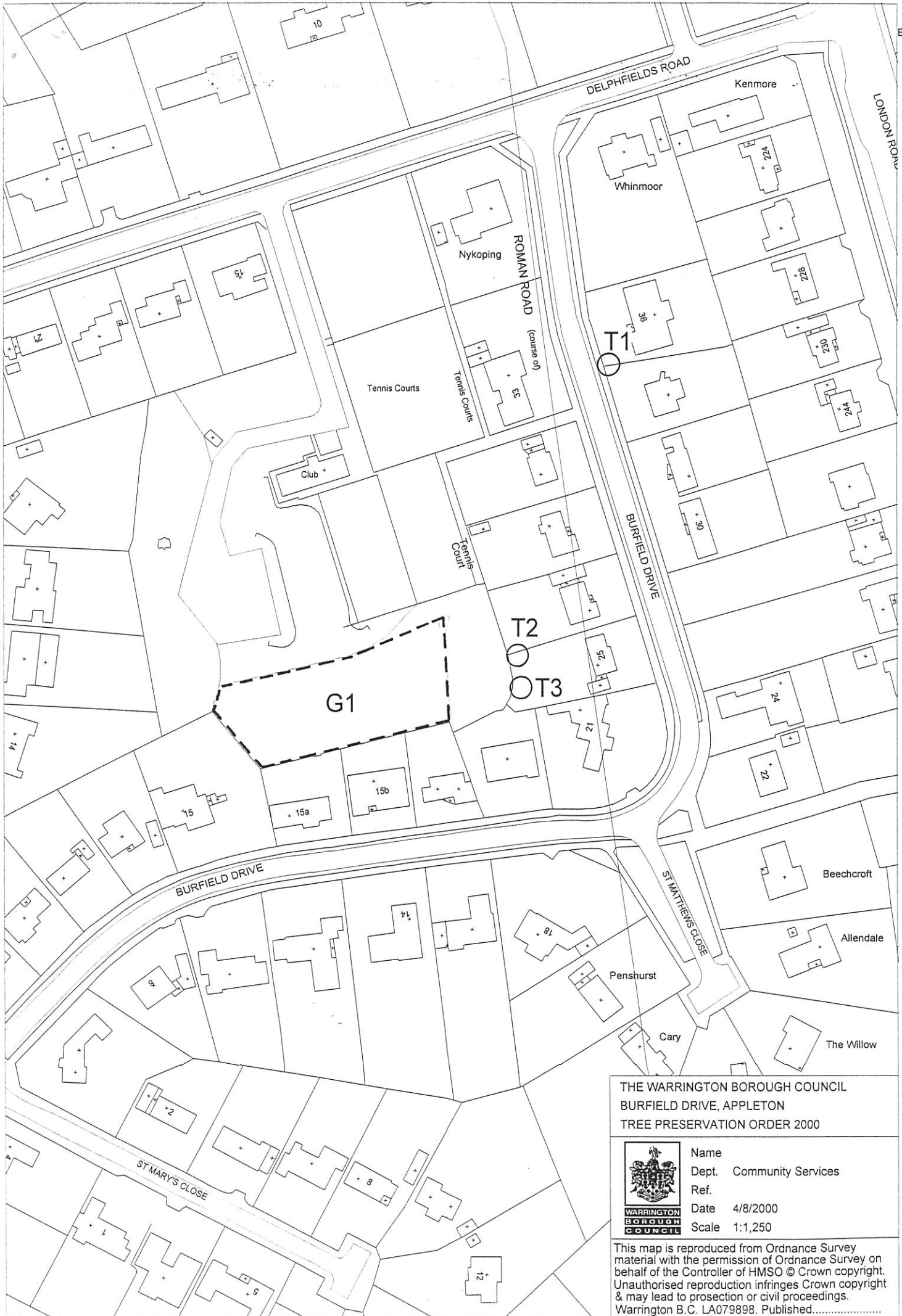
