
THE WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL (PINWAYS, APPLETON)
TREE PRESERVATION ORDER 1975

The **WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL** ("the Authority") did on 2 July 1975 make the above Tree Preservation Order ("the Order") pursuant to Section 60 and Section 61 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 ("the Act") the Order being subsequently confirmed by the Authority with modifications on the 23 October 1975.

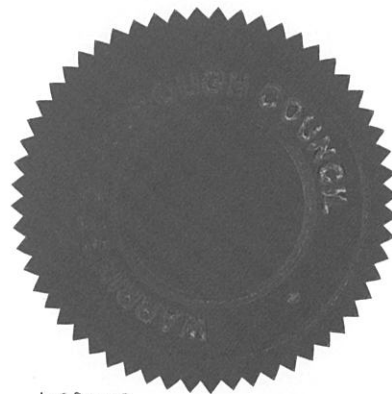
The Authority now hereby varies the Order pursuant to Section 198 and Section 201 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 ("the Act") as shown in Schedule 1 which shall now be designated as the Warrington Borough Council (Pineways, Appleton) Tree Preservation Order 2000.
