

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1990, SECTION 119
WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL
(CROFT FOOTPATH NO.11) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2017**

This Order is made by Warrington Borough Council ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Croft Parish Council has been consulted as required under Section 120 of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Croft and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order subject to certification of the completion of works to surface the new footpath described in Part 2 below to the reasonable satisfaction of the Council.
2. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order by a public footpath over the land situated at Croft described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY


From a point on the footpath approximately 588 metres along the footpath from its junction with Heath Lane at O.S grid reference SJ6370894781 running in a generally easterly direction to a point on the footpath at O.S. grid reference SJ6386394797, a distance of approximately 166 metres, A – B as indicated on the map. The footpath is 2 metres wide.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

From a point on the footpath approximately 588 metres along the footpath from its junction with Heath Lane at O.S grid reference SJ6370894781 running south easterly into the adjoining field then in a generally easterly direction along a crushed stone surfaced footpath near the field edge then turning northerly to leave the field then north easterly to rejoin the footpath at O.S grid reference SJ6386394797, a distance of approximately 177m., A – B as indicated on the map. The footpath is 2 metres wide.

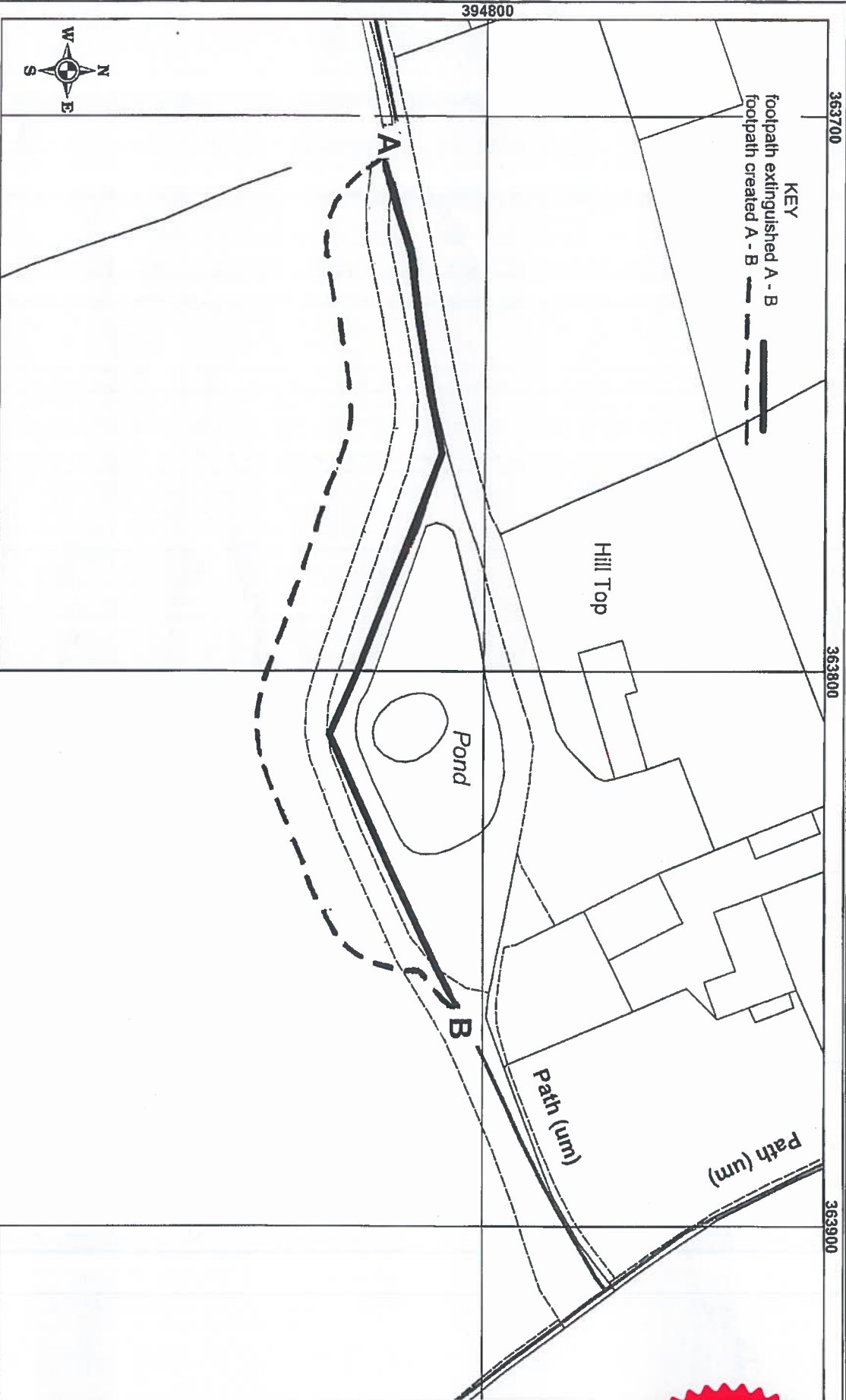
