

**NOTICE OF LEGAL EVENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981, SECTION 53**

**THE WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT**

**WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION (OMNIBUS) ORDER**  
**2018**

The above Order, made on 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018 under Section 53 (2) (b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, modified the Definitive Map and Statement in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3) (a) of the Act, namely the coming into operation of enactments or instruments and other events, whereby:-

- (i) highways shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statements have been authorised to be stopped up, diverted, widened or extended;
- (ii) highways shown or required to be shown in the Map and Statement as highways of a particular description have ceased to be highways or that description;
- (iii) new rights of way have been created over lands in the area to which the Map relates, being rights of way such that the lands over which the rights subsist are public paths.

A copy of the Order and the Order Map may be seen free of charge at Contact Warrington, 28 Horsemarket Street, Warrington, Cheshire from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. Monday to Friday and 9.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Saturdays. Copies of the Order may be bought there at the price of £1.00.

The Order came into force on the 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018, but if a person aggrieved by the Order wants to question its validity or any provisions contained in it, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 or on the grounds of any requirement of the Act or of any regulations made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, under Paragraph 12 of Schedule 15 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 16<sup>th</sup> October 2018 make an application to the High Court.
