Land at Dam Lane, Hollins Green

We attach a Call for Sites Registration Form which we wish to supplement with the following representation.

- 1. In relation to the Green Belt Study the conclusion of the consultants is that the site overall makes a strong contribution to the purposes of the Green Belt whilst acknowledging that Dam Lane to the East and the houses to the South form a durable Green Belt boundary. The certainty in planning terms of HS2 will reinforce this boundary and will alter the basis upon which the findings of the Green Belt Study is predicated.
- 2. Hollins Green provides a primary school and a pre-school, is served by an hourly bus service between Manchester Shudehill Interchange and the Warrington Interchange. Glazebrook railway station is nearby and provides easy travel to Manchester, Liverpool and Warrington. The A57 adjoins the village and M6 junction 21 is 2½ miles to the West with access from there to the M62 and M56 minutes away. There are two pubs. As such an extension to the village would be sustainable in planning terms.
- 3. This site constitutes a deliverable housing site well related to a viable settlement which is capable of readily meeting the demands for housing within the Green Belt.

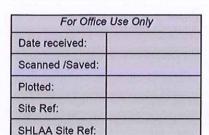
