

LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for:

Marshalls, 111 Wilderspool Causeway, Warrington, WA4 6PX

The grounds for review are that the nature and style of the operation of the premises is undermining the licensing objectives, particularly:

- The Prevention of Crime and Disorder (failing to ensure an effective CCTV system is operational within the premises).
- The Protection of Children from harm (repeated allegations of underage persons buying alcohol from the premises and breaching conditions that could help prevent the sale of alcohol to young people).

The register containing a record of the grounds for review can be inspected by appointment on Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 16:30 (except bank holidays) at the offices of the Licensing Authority at:

Warrington Borough Council, New Town House, Buttermarket Street, Warrington, WA1 2NH

Any interested party or responsible authority wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the **Monday 26**th **March 2018.**

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of £5000 on summary conviction.
