

LICENSING ACT 2003: NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE

TAKE NOTICE that an application has been made pursuant to Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 for the review of the premises licence in force for Rag & Bone. Rusgan House, Barbauld Street, Warrington, WA1 2QZ.

The grounds for review are that there have been several sales of alcohol to customers under 18 years of age as well as drug taking and dealing inside the premises. The nature and style of the operation of the premises is undermining the licensing objectives particularly:

- Prevention of Crime & Disorder
- Public Safety
- Protection of Children from Harm

The register containing a record of the grounds for review can be inspected by appointment on Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 16:30 (except bank holidays) at the offices of the Licensing Authority at:

Any responsible authority or other person wishing to make representations on the application must do so to the Licensing Authority of Warrington Borough Council referred to above. Representations must be in writing and must be received by the Licensing Authority no later than the **30**th **June 2014.**

It is an **offence** knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application punishable with a maximum fine of £5000 on summary conviction.
