The Panel's recommendations represent no change from the revised 2016/17 Scheme, except as follows:-

• The Basic Allowance shall increase annually in accordance with a percentage amount for inflation as determined by any positive value of the Consumer Price Index (CPI) as at February immediately prior to the introduction of a new Scheme and shall be so indexed for a period of four years commencing on 1 April 2016 and ending on 31 March 2020. In the event of a negative value for inflation (deflation) there will be no change to the level of Basic Allowance.

The recommendations of the Panel were submitted to the Council on 21 March and 22 June 2016, Revised 19 June 2017, then revised 18 June 2018, then revised 17 June 2019 with effect for the period 1 April 2019 to 31 March 2020.
