Dear Sir/Madam,

I object Very strongly to the preposterous proposed changes/developments to Greenbelt Land next to Lingley Mere and Omega and the horrendous knock on effect to our local area.

All Greenbelt land and residential areas should remain undeveloped and unspoilt as this area should.

We already have more than enough houses, Commercial development and Warehousing in this area and we certainly do not need anymore.

I used to like Wainington and Great Sankey when I first moved to the area [redacted]. I am very quickly beginning to dislike it immensely, as it's becoming far too over developed and not a very pleasant place to live anymore. We need to keep our Greenbelt land and Countryside intact and unspoilt.

Reasons:

- 1). Wildlife - This area is a haven for wildlife and nature including rare & protected species.
- 2). Health - Huge detrimental effect on health and the environment. I have family members with very serious Asthma. Air pollution and noise pollution would be totally unacceptable. I've already noticed an increase in noise and traffic through the night when trying to get to sleep and have in fact been woken up by noisy lorries, HGV's in the middle of the night, causing stress and anxiety.
- 3). Traffic Congestion - The roads in this area and in Wainington in general are already full to capacity, grid locked and hugely problematic. I now struggle to cross the road [redacted] leading from Lingley Mere Business Park to the Trigger Pond, as it's solid and jammed, it's ridiculous and very frustrating.

There are places for development in large cities, already urbanised Industrial areas and should be nowhere near to private residential areas and certainly not here on Greenbelt land.
