

Dear Sir Re Objection to PDO

I am very disappointed that a decision affecting so much of Warrington was only released into the public domain as people were heading into the summer holidays and Parish Councils were in their summer recess. This has meant that my response is not as measured and researched as it should be over such an important matter.

My summary points are:

The current road network cannot cope and has been unable to cope from the south of Warrington for many years. the introduction of more properties and businesses to the numbers shown will only force people to look elsewhere and be counter productive to the 'success' Warrington at looking for. It is surrounded by water and motorways just sometimes expansion cannot happen.
