Subject: "Warrington local plan" Proposal for 495 houses off Red Lane Appleton

Proposal to build 1800 new houses on green belt land in South Warrington.

I am writing to object to the above proposal

As a local resident I find this totally unacceptable

I am sympathetic to the needs of housing supply but the loss of 'green spaces' is unforgivable given the large tracts of previously developed space across the town that could be reused for housing eg. The wasteland around Warrington Central station, unused previously developed space around Birchwood etc

The roads in the proposed affected area are already poor, the traffic too dense and the other infrastructure (bridges over the canal, local schools, medical centre) do not have capacity, so this proposal creates a range of safeguarding issues. It makes the area of south Warrington less attractive which, in the end, will harm the Warrington economy.

We need more intelligent plans than simply levelling precious green spaces that define the boundaries of the town
