To whom it may concern,

I am contacting you to officially lodge my strong objection to Warrington Borough Council's Local Plan Review, Call for Sites. References R18/031, R18/032, R18/052, R18/093, R18/095, R18/098, R18/099, R18/115, R18/127, R18/129, R18/155.

These plans amount to a destruction of the village and will forever alter Croft's rural aspect.

As well as the loss of the green space and the resulting impact this will have on the wildlife, I do not believe that the village infrastructure can cope with these additional houses. There are already road signs in positions warning of collision Red Routes and leaving Cross Lane onto Warrington Road at peak travel time is already congested.

The reason I moved to Croft over [REDACTED] years ago was due to its rural location and this will be destroyed by these plans and the whole nature of the village will be lost for ever.

There are many brownfield sites throughout Warrington which are more suitable to meet the housing need than the small village of Croft.
