**Warrington Borough Council – Local Plan Preferred Development Option.**

I am writing in to objection to the above plan which I think should be completely scrapped.

 The land you are proposing to develop in Walton and Moore in the plans is green belt. It is a buffer between Warrington and Runcorn. This green belt is absolutely essential to stop the towns becoming one big urban conurbation. The beautiful villages of Moore and Higher Walton will be lost.
