


Dear Sir / Madam

I am writing to object to WBC's preferred Development Option (Regulation 18 Consultation July 2017).

My main concerns are in relation to the proposal to build approx. 2000 homes on land between A56 and Runcorn Road (option 2).

WBC's justification in releasing this land from green belt is flawed in that it does not take into account that Moore (immediately joining the planned site of development) is both a historic village with listed buildings and a conservation area, but also in the only settlement between Halton & Warrington. To allow this south west extension to take place will erode the green belt between the two boroughs irrevocably and result in Moore losing its identity.

I am also extremely concerned about the development of Port Warrington: its impact on both Moore Nature Reserve and Promenade Park (residential are of 80 + homes in Moore). The current infrastructure in South Warrington area cannot cope with expansion at this level and I urge you to re-think your proposals to build both this number of homes and allow the development of Port Warrington without the required assessments and proper investigative works.

I  moved to the area to escape the 'busy' life of the Warrington town centre. I feel this development will severely affect our quality of life and the benefits we have of living in a green environment.

I feel the loss of the Nature Reserve in particular will be a massive hit on both the community and local environment.
