

Comments: As a family who has lived in this area of Hill Cliffe Road for over 20 years we strongly object to the plan to build 495 houses on Red Lane and Walton Lea Road. Stockton Heath is already congested with traffic, and the Red Lane bridge is at a standstill during commuting time. Hill Cliffe Road is already used as a "cut through" for traffic looking to avoid Stockton Heath centre and this ridiculous proposal will make our road even busier. With most households these days owning up to 3 cars each, this could mean up to an additional 1500 cars in a very localised area. Our local economy has benefited enormously in recent years as families have been attracted to the area mainly for the amount of healthy attractive green space and walking areas.
