We wish to state our objections to the proposal by Peel Holdings to build 220+ houses in this area of Croft:

- The loss of precious greenbelt amenity. There are surely brownfield sites somewhere in the Warrington area where former buildings have been demolished and the land left derelict.
- (2) The narrow winding roads through Croft village could not absorb the immense increase in traffic engendered by an extra 220 households, plus the noise and pollution.
- (3) Croft needs its open spaces and green fields. This is the countryside and this is what makes it special.
