Dear Council,

I am strongly objecting to your PDD for Warrington. The sheer number of houses being proposed for South Warrington is overwhelming. How are these figures arrived at? Who is driving them? Greedy developers and Peel Holdings? Why the inequality?

The villages of Burtonwood, Culeby, Croft, Glazebury and Hollins Green are being protected BUT the villages of Appleton Thorn, Chappenhall, Moore, Skelton and Walton are to lose their identity, character, history and heritage to Urban Sprawl on a monumental scale.

The impact of your plans on traffic will be horrendous. Whenever there are problems on either the M6 or the M56, Stockton Heath becomes gridlocked. This traffic will increase with the imposed tolls on the Runcorn-Widnes bridges and raising the price of the Mersey Tunnels forcing commercial traffic through

Warrington.  
Healthcare is running at capacity, it is impossible  
to make an appointment with a doctor now.  
Warrington Hospital is bursting at the seams.

We live on a flood plain. After today's rain  
our garden is under water due to the building  
of a housing estate across the road, never a  
problem before.

Loss of Green Belt, green space and the  
countryside which makes South Warrington  
an attractive place to live, will be detrimental  
to all residents. In your own Core Policy document  
CS1 and CS2 you clearly state, Priority is  
to protect Green Belt and the character of  
the countryside until 2032.

Who are ARUP to say our Green Belt is  
weak? Who are they paid by? Developers who  
prefer to build on green sites to avoid  
Brownfield clean-up costs? Brownfield should  
be used first.

I urge the Council to rethink these  
proposals and consider the very negative  
impact on the residents of South Warrington.
