To whom it may concern

I am writing regarding the PDO currently under consideration and I would like to give my reasons as to why I feel it should not go ahead.

Firstly Warringtons roads are not equipped to take the amount of traffic on the roads already. Any expansion would make this worse. Average another 1 1/2 cars per household plus increase in heavy goods vehicles and we will be at standstill every day.
