On behalf of the residents of [REDACTED] Runcorn Road. We strongly reject the proposals to surround all of the properties in the area with what can only be described as urban sprawl. It is inconceivable to think these historical buildings listed as a place of interest will not be protected by not only the green belt but by Warrington council. All of these cottages and buildings look upon one another with some of the best views in Warrington and have done for over 100 years which will be lost forever if the development takes place. Building 2000 houses along with approximately 5000 people and 4000 cars plus heavy traffic from the new link road it will almost certainly have a catastrophic polluting effect on this area and the surrounding areas including Walton and Stockton Heath where a good percentage of the traffic will be heading. Is this really the councils vision or is it Peel Holdings vision who are desperate for this link road for port Warrington. With more and more accidents on the M6, M56 and M62 this link road will be one of the longest rat runs in the North West. The A5060 will become one of the busiest and polluted roads in Warrington if this goes ahead. We feel that Warrington Council should support not only the residents of Higher Walton but also recognise the importance of the green belt between Warrington and Moore or these landscapes will be lost forever.
