Dear Sir

I am writing with an objection to the number of houses being proposed in Burtonwood. we do not have enough facilities to support so many houses. We dont have enough decent shops we have a doctors surgery that opens 4 mornings a week the roads are not suitable for over five thousand people.

I live on a main Road and see the traffic between 7-0-9-30 and 4-6-30 in the afternoon, two weeks ago I had a doctors appointment at 8-45 it took me fifteen mins to reverse off my drive, we have a 30 MPH limit no one takes any notice

I went to a traffic Calming meeting over ten years ago and still nothing has been done we have a 7.5 tonne goods limit that is not observed, and nothing is done about it.

about two weeks ago in the afternoon a wagon came past with at least 30 tonnes of steel Girders on and in the evening 40 Tonne wagons go past regularly, I catch the bus often on Fir tree Lane, the footpath at the busstop is about two feet wide when the bushes are growing it is less you are stood on the edge of the kerb with the traffic going past, in the morning and afternoon the traffic is coming from Newton and St Helens trying to get to omega and June SA on the M-62

I have a friend who lives in Tan house Lane, the traffic are using Tan house Lane as a short cut to get to omega he says he was lucky to see a handful of cars a day now he sees hundreds a day this road is a narrow winding road with a lot of blind corners, there are no footpaths, there are stables on this road, with horses and riders using it all the time.

one of the main culprits on this road are argos vans who come off the M-62 and take a short cut to their depot in newton they should go to the next junction and get on the A-49. The roads in Burtonwood are not even B roads and the extra traffic wont help, that is why I must object to the large number of extra houses
