I wish to log my opposition to the preferred development of Warrington being made into a City.

[REDACTED] I believe the implementation of a possible dual carriage way, to accommodate significant green belt building, will be extremely detrimental to our current way of life.

This will add a high amount of congestion to the already struggling one way system in Latchford Village. Crating safety hazards for the many young families that use this as a route to work, school and day-to-day errands.
