I am writing to register my concern that Lymm is expected to allow/require 500 new homes to be built in the immediate locality over the next 20 years.

My concern is that the land to be chosen should be selected carefully for the benefit of the area, not the sole benefit of the landowners prepared to profit from the land sales.

1. Green Belt should be preserved, unless there is no reasonable alternative. Wildlife will be reduced if this land is used up.
2. Extra homes means road widening schemes, on roads that are already full at peak times.
3. The village centre of Lymm should be maintained to ensure that local businesses can survive.
