

I wish to register my strong objections to the proposal to build thousands of homes, and commercial buildings for dozens of businesses in the area around Grappenhall, Thelwall and Appleton Thorn, much of it on Green Belt land!. It is unbelievable that there are plans for a 'garden city suburb', which will completely ruin the character of the whole area

My principal objections are as follows:-

- 1. The plan concentrates development in the south east of the borough, when all major facilities (with the exception of motorway access) are north of the Bridgewater Canal and the Manchester Ship Canal Health care facilities, railway stations, bus station and major shopping facilities. Surely, the scale of development is such that it should be spread amoung many areas of the borough, and should utilise some of the many available brown field sites.
- 2. Why choose this area for massive development. Major problems will be that schools are full, doctor and dentist lists are full, roads are already completely inadequate and there are no plans to include them in the proposals. All of these are not only vital, but need to be in place before any construction takes place.
