I am emailing to lodge my objection to the proposed huge scale development plan in Warringtons Greenbelt area.

A degree of development at Pewterspear, Appleton Cross and Grappenhall Heys was always know about soon after we moved to Appleton Thorn in [REDACTED] but the new proposals go too far, and the scale is too big making Warrington South an undesirable place to live for those who already live here or come over to visit and enjoy the greener areas of the town.
