I wish to express my concerns about the proposed building on Peel Hall Park.

This is not the first time this company has requested permission to build and huge development on this land and I'm not clear on why they don't understand the word NO.

The area they wish to use is the only large green space we have left in North Warrington and the area is well used by local people. It is also our buffer between the M62 and the residential area which helps to deaden the noise of the motorway while the trees and plants help to remove the pollutants in the air.

If this land is turned into a huge residential area we will experience many problems including:

- * many more cars on already very congested, regularly gridlocked roads.
- * much more air pollution.
- * local services would be unable to cope with the influx of more people i.e. hospital/doctors/dentists/schools/emergency services.
- * the huge loss of local wildlife and flowers and fauna.

With the building of Chapelford and the many other areas of Warrington being reused for housing I really do think enough is enough.
