Over the years we have both welcomed the growth in housing with the developments of Cherry Fields, Rushes Meadow & Ridgeway Gardens however these proposals are far too excessive for the Village and it's essential they are down sized to a more sensible level to avoid loosing the community values of living in Lymm.

The plans need to be revised, there is no mention of the impact of the housing to the infrastructure which is already at capacity TODAY there are issues with

-The volume of traffic using Cherry Lane from the M6

-Traffic through the village/ brook road as a through fair to M60/M62

-Traffic over Warburton bridge at peak times

- the increase in businesses in traditional residential areas without provision for employees parking resulting in Ridiculous parking situations impacting drivers.

-The increase in charges in structured car parks forcing Lymm business drivers to park on A roads all day resulting in grid locks along the Higher Lane & Brook Road for example

- Both doctors & dentist at capacity.
