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As a lifelong resident of Grappenhall I am well aware of the benefits of living in the area, and can see how a further housing development will enable more people to enjoy similar benefits.

I am however very concerned about how the infrastructure will work to enable both existing and new residents to travel around to enjoy their daily lives. As you will be aware most journeys in or around the area have to either cross over, or go under a canal and peak times are already very congested. If a problem occurs on any of the surrounding motorways, traffic becomes even heavier on all the local roads.

I am concerned that Broad Lane will be unable to cope with the extra traffic and it will be even more dangerous for residents and children travelling to and from the local primary school - there is already insufficient parking in Grappenhall village and this adds to congestion at the bottom of Broad Lane on a daily basis. Stockton Lane has been closed for more than 10 years as a through road for traffic and is already deemed to be too dangerous for the existing amount of traffic, so again I can't see from the plans how that will be made safer.

Is there any detail you can give to me to confirm that all the above issues have been taken into account within your current proposals?
