I am writing to register my objection to the "Warrington Preferred Development Option" and how it will affect myself and my neighbourhood.

[REDACTED] Monday received a leaflet through the letterbox about a proposed high level bridge over the canal, and road continuing to Bridge Foot along the former railway line. The leaflet was to warn residents of this proposal and the potential for it to disrupt our lives. (We had previously heard nothing from the Council on this matter). Under the proposal, all houses either side of the former railway line would be made subject to a Compulsary Purchase Order, meaning that either I would be evicted from my home or would have a major road going at the back of my house. When I moved to the area in the [REDACTED] we were surrounded by fields and now there is more and more unnecessary development taking place.
