WARRINGTON NEW CITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN, PREFERRED OPTION

I have just returned from a weeks's holiday and the first piece of post I read was the flyer published by volunteers on the newly formed objectors group which outlined the above proposals. This was the first I or my neighbours had heard of this plan, let alone the proposed high level bridge & major road which would run right where my house is!

I hastily looked up the the plan on the council's download website and its title would never have led me to understand it was proposing the demolition of my home to make way for a high level bridge and bypass. I don't call that consultation , I call that obfuscation straight out of 'Yes Minister' or Hitch hikers Guide to the Galaxy. Now the "consultation period" is almost over and I haven't even had sufficient time to digest all the details of the plan and its wider ramifications for the green belt, wildlife, quality of life, feasibility, etc.

Why was this not published and sent to householders affected (in a user friendly way or synopsis) to draw the attention of your constituents? I intend to object obviously, not just because it affects my home , but if it goes ahead it will simply deposit all the traffic in the town centre to increase the existing bottleneck there.
