1 higher levels of pollution in an already highly polluted area-one of the worst in the UK

- 2 no adequate funding for high capital expenditure to create and maintain roads.
- 3 The town cannot cope with the proposed routes. Not serving the areas which need them.
- 4 no consideration for the infrastructure currently in place or people's homes and lives
- 5 The proposed new road from Stretton to Grappenhall would destroy natural habitat, ponds, woodland and goes straight into the main fuel pumping station from Ellesmere Port to Carrington.
- 6 if the council cannot maintain the current roads how can it afford any new ones? 7 hgv should be banned from the start. As shown last week when attempting to cross hump back canal bridges.
- 8 no other town has to cope with a river, rail line, shop canal and Bridgewater canal between itself and South of the town. Town hall transport team say they have modelled the area against similar towns of population size, and they don't have issues. But they don't our history or transport/logistical crossings.
- 9 We bought our property for the fresh air and countryside. The LTP4 will destroy South warrington and open the green spaces for building and houses-over estimated predictions. 10 The proposed new roads will deter buyers from the area, not encourage. Protect our green spaces.
