I am writing to express my concern, as the local plans for the future of South Warrington unfold.

[REDACTED] the children at St Matthews school are going to be put at risk by traffic emerging onto an already very busy road. I understand that st Matthews had been refused planning permission for an extension in recent years on these grounds. It seems that child safety is not as important as money.

Medical centres are already full, roads are too busy, schools are full.

The Infrastructure is completely inadequate and there are no solutions to this problem on the plans.

Pollution, air quality and environmental damage are way too high already. Health is going to suffer. The excessive building work means that the quality of life will be much worse. Warrington has the worst record in the country for dangerous micron emissions. This is going to put even more strain on local health services.

Having read what information is available to me I believe the plans are based on old data and ambitious assumptions, that the destruction of communities and health will be the price to pay with little concern for the people who live here now
We will have unrelenting traffic and pollution with grossly underfunded infrastructure projects therefore the plan has to be undeliverable.
