I wish to express my concern regarding the local development plan for Warrington, particularly the plans for the south of the town. I have attended several meetings and presentations which highlighted the destruction of large parts of the towns green belt. Warrington has been identified by the World Health Organisation as having some of the worst air pollution in Europe, it is therefore essential that the greenbelt be left in place.

The transport links are already failing to cope especially around the Thelwall viaduct, the planned number of houses to be built cannot be serviced by either the current or the planned infrastructure. It is obvious that this plan has been developed by people with little or no understanding of South Warrington,

The recent announcement by SSE that Fiddlers Ferry power station is to be closed within the next couple of years means that Warrington has the possibility to meet most of it's housing needs by building on brown field sites.

Both the local development plans for housing, transport and the Six56 site are unsound, cannot be delivered and need a wholesale rethink.
