Sir / Madam,

You will have had many comments , but I would like to raise this point . It applies to Lymm , but may be aplicable elsewhere.

In Lymm the bulk of the proposed housing is on the north side and many of these people will be leaving Lymm to work . Traveling North is not easy — due to the Manchester Ship Canal which has few bridges . To the south lies the village centre with its narrow 20 mph residential streets also the — Bridgewater Canal which has few bridge , mainly narrow and hump-backed . To the East any road improvements must be agreed with the next local — authority , Trafford . To the West will mean traversing more 20 mph residential streets .

Thus what at first sight seems to be a good location for houses has a number of access problems . These can , of course , be solved by spending — money and taking over even more Green Belt land for road widening and probably new roads and bridges over the canal .
