LOCAL PLAN

I object to proposals for the local plan for Warrington on the grounds that it is not sound.

I oppose the loss of Green Belt land for development. It is not justified to lose nearly all the Green Belt land in South Warrington leaving only a few small areas.

Recent evidence shows that pollution is causing serious health problems. We live in an area with motorways and major roads which are often congested. Green areas are needed to reduce pollution. Mental and physical health is improved by green areas.

Brown field sites should be used. This would improve those areas and public transport links should be given priority to these areas. Public transport is very poor in South Warrington and most new homes in these areas have several cars.

Derelict and unused properties near town centres should be developed to provide homes which have good transport links.

Please take these points into account when deciding on the future of South Warrington.
