Local Planned development, Green Lane, Burtonwood, 2020

I am writing in reference to the above consultation.

I understand the need for additional housing and have no objection in principal to the development of this land.

However, I do need to stress the need for guaranteed improvements to doctors and school places in the village.

1. Green Lane Primary School is already oversubscribed and additional children associated with the development will only exacerbate this situation. Plans to develop the school must be included in any permission for the housing development.
2. We already wait for up to 2 weeks for a doctor's appointment in the village if we do not have our own transport to travel to Newton-Le-Willows, so again there must be guaranteed improvements to this service.
3. We have no facilities for children in the villages other than Beavers/Scouts and Football/Rugby. Children need a greater choice of activities to help combat the weight and fitness problems that are affecting children nationwide.
4. I believe the main problem with this development is the limited access from Green Lane. If additional access could be provided from Lumber Lane and Aldridge Drive this would ease the congestion on Green Lane.

As I said at the start of this letter, I understand the need for additional housing but guarantees to the local infrastructure and facilities must be included in any permission.
