Please find below my objection to the local plan:

I believe it is based on unjustified and old economic growth data using ambitious assumptions for overwhelming house building schemes of 18,900 houses across Warrington by 2037.

Also, the plans for commercial premises near Appleton Thorn/ Grappenhall situated on approx. 365 hectares of pristine land some of it precious Green Belt land I believe these premises would be 2nd biggest in the country behind Trafford Park and this seems to contradict the urge to meet clean air targets . Warrington already has worst record in the country for dangerous small 2.5-micron particulate emissions and I want the council to do more for the future healths of my children with this local plan.

The 7400 houses in South Warrington alone, around Appleton Thorn and Grappenhall will result in the destruction of village character and the surrounding landscape which are the reasons my husband and I have chosen to live and bring up our children here. I am really concerned about; additional traffic, 2,000 HGVs per hour from Langtree Six/56 commercial warehousing site, pollution and air quality, increased noise and the destruction of green belt land with no special circumstances to release GB for new build premises. We do not get a planet B so let's not destroy the green fields we have, this should be a last resort

I believe south Warrington is already suffering from poor traffic and this new plan seems to have a poor transport strategy lacking in essential details. Therefore in my opinion the whole plan is unsound and undeliverable to the people of south Warrington.
