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I am writing to object to the local plan on the following grounds my name is Joy Williams, [REDACTED]

- the number of houses being proposed to be built cannot be justified. It is an extrapolation of a growth rate in 2014 which is no longer valid, if more recent demand was considered it would dramatically reduce the number of houses being proposed

. the plan proposes overwhelming number of houses in south Warrington which would destroy the village character and landscape of the area

- the local transport plan to support the development of these houses is woefully inadequate, it has simply not been developed to an adequate level. The roads in South Warrington are already congested and pressing ahead with this development plus Stobarts and Six 56 will simply bring traffic to a standstill. Warrington is already one of the most polluted towns in the northwest adding to this problem is unacceptable.

- the plan to potentially build on greenfield land is not justified and there are no exceptional circumstances to justify this particularly when additional brownfield land will inevitably become available before 2037. The plan is simply over too long a duration and once we free up greenfield for development we will never get it back.
