Hello,

I am finding it difficult to complete the "representation form" online, so I am using email to register my objections.

1. I am concerned about the type of housing that is planned. Little of it will be affordable housing. It won't help to alleviate the housing shortage for people on low wages.
2. The type of housing that is proposed is mismatched with the type of work that the Local Plan is likely to encourage. These jobs will be mainly low paid warehouse jobs and the people who take them won't be able to work near to the proposed housing. This has an impact on transport and pollution. It will do little to help people out of poverty.
3. I have been concerned from the start about the consultation process used by Warrington Borough Council, (or lack of consultation). It was flawed from the beginning and should have been scrapped. You need to start these things by asking the people what they would like to see in terms of growth. People are well aware that there has to be a "Local Plan", as imposed by the government. What they have not liked is the "top down" approach. We need to work together on these matters.
4. I am very concerned about pollution from the extra traffic on additional roads and the likelihood of people using Warrington as a "rat-run".
5. I would like the Independent Planning Inspector to be able to speak to residents and the various objection groups, as some of the WBC data that has been used I believe to be outdated.
6. We have in the last week heard that Fiddler's Ferry is to close. How will this fit into the plan? What will happen to the site? Can this be used for housing?
