No consideration of the use of Brown field sites- of which there is many. The Fiddlers Ferry site has announced imminent closure. These sorts of sites should be utilised long before Green Belt land is taken from all of us with no way of reversing such short sighted plans, which will destroy the character and distinctiveness of our villages, as well as the wellbeing of the local ecology as well as the wellbeing of your population of residents/people for whom council planners are responsible! The governments new climate change targets will not be served by the massive increase in traffic with inadequate infrastructure and increase of air pollution here, which is already amongst the worst in the country! Simple logistics and geography already cause access problems for traffic on a daily basis attempting to navigate across

the River Mersey, Manchester Ship Canal, and Bridgewater canal.

5000 new homes built in the areas proposed will produce even more problems with poor access to railways and bus services too. There is not enough detail or adequate plans showing infrastructure (roads bridges, schools, medical centres etc) to support this local plan. This plan is definitely NOT a "sound" plan.
