I would like to make known my objection to the proposed Local plan. I am horrified at the thought of losing any of our precious green belt land which is vital to the health and well being of the people of Warrington. The town already has the worst record for air pollution, identified by The World Health Organization, and there is a proven link between exposure to small particles and premature death. Relentless additional traffic will only compound this problem. Overwhelming house building , commercial properties and warehousing on prime green belt land is unacceptable and unnecessary and a violation. There are plenty of brown field sites which could be utilized for building so called needed housing and warehousing not to mention the Fiddlers Ferry site now that it's closure has been confirmed.

I live close to Bridge Foot and witness on a daily basis the nightmare of gridlock, noise and emissions. This is already insufferable and will only get worse if these plans based on old data and ambitious assumptions go ahead. I believe the transport strategy to be flawed, lacking essential detail and I believe will be grossly under funded.
