I am strongly objecting to the Local Plan for Warrington. I live in **the second** and was attracted to the area because of the attractive countryside and the surrounding villages. The scale of the proposed plan and the release of greenbelt will dramatically change the nature of this area forever and become an urban sprawl. I do not believe that the very special circumstances required to release greenbelt land has been demonstrated or the use of brownfield sites fully investigated. The proposed plan does not seem to consider increased traffic congestion and resulting air pollution given that Warrington is cited by WHO as having one of the worst records for air pollution resulting in premature deaths. The vast scale of the new houses and warehouses being proposed does not seem to correlate with the latest 2016 population growth figures and I am concerned that the supporting infrastructure required will not be deliverable. Currently the schools and GP surgeries are already overstretched. Whilst I appreciate some development is required I do not believe this plan is sound or deliverable based on the existing proposal.
