I would like to object to the Local Plan Proposal on the basis of the following points:

. The overwhelming house build across Warrington by 2037

. The enormous size of commercial premises planned for the vicinity of Appleton Thorn and Grappenhall. Green belt land is to be used to create one of the largest commercial areas in the country.

. The 74,000 houses planned for development around Appleton Thorn. This will destroy the character of the village - it will become an urban sprawl with no individual character as it has now.

. There will be a dramatic increase in air pollution to a level which will be severely detrimental to residents health causing respiratory and heart problems.

. There appears to be no 'special' circumstances to release green belt land for new premises.

. These plans are a contradiction of Thorn Ward Neighbourhood Development Plan.

. There is insufficient infrastructure to cope with the increase of vehicles and people.

. There is an underfunding for appropriate infrastructure.
