Why I am worried about the large development plan in South Warrington.

You are Planning to build up to 5000 houses in the area. How will the roads cope with all the extra traffic. The roads to the motorway, schools and work in the morning and evenings are already grid locked. Drivers use Dudlow Green Road as a race track trying to avoid London Road to get to Warrington or the M6 and M56. Do we have to swim over the Ship Canal? There is no evidence of a satisfactory solution to this major barrier. You don't seem to have any serious plans for new roads, schools, new Doctors surgeries. Now Stockton Heath is mainly Restaurants, eating places and hairdressers enjoying a declining in shopping capacity. Are we going to have to travel further for shopping, again causing traffic chaos.
