- 1. I don't think the plan is deliverable
- 2. The housing numbers that drive the plan are unrealistic in view of what Warrington has achieved in the past
- 3. Warrington Council should challenge them instead of pressing ahead with them
- 4. There needs to be liaison with neighbouring authorities
- 5. Details of the plans for the roads are vague. The only firm proposal is for a dual carriageway from Barley Castle to Junction 10. It does nothing to support the new housing
- 6. Nothing is planned to improve the A49 going north from the M56
- 7. There is no definitive proposal for how the residents of south Warrington will get into town.
- 8. I don't see how the plan will result in the regeneration of the town centre or preserve the identity of our area.
- 9. The plan does not clearly show what the "very special circumstances" are for development in the green belt
- 10. I doubt whether the supporting infrastructure for the houses on the green belt will be built
- 11. We risk the green belt being lost because of an over ambitious plan.
- 12. The integrity of our villages would be threatened
