Warrington has, for as long as I remember, had traffic issues. As a South Warrington resident I barely attempt to cross the bridges as rush hour becomes longer and the a49 through Stockton Heath is barely clear at any time of day, however there are necessities. Firstly we have no petrol station, I am unable to find a dentist and the Dr's is full to bursting. The schools are full and nursery places are hard to find. The infrastructure isnt in place for the amount of houses already and adding thousands more without a forward thinking plan and new links to Warrington is irresponsible and frustrating for all of us who already work our lives around ageing swing bridges. The pollution in Stockton Heath already with idling vehicles is a worry for locals health.

I commute using the roads from Appleton Thorn to the M56 past where there is currently warehouse depots and industrial units. The roads are already heavy with HGVs, full of litter and increased traffic in this area without traffic lights or thought as to vehicle movement is increasing the risk of collisions.

The loss of greenbelt without any real reason other than you feel you can under a vague banner of "very special circumstances" is taking advantage of a position and I urge that this massive proposal be given the due thought and diligence it deserves.
