I wish to object to the local plan. The idea of massive housing development on south Warrington is rash and totally inappropriate. It will

- 1 remove unique green belt to the detriment of the whole town
- 2 destroy the ethos of the villages
- 3 massively increase the traffic in an already congested area
- 4 clog up totally inappropriate roads as residents desperately attempt to identify rabbit runs to make progress in the chaos
- 5 endanger the health of the residents and their children because of the direct (more traffic accidents) and indirect (increased fumes)
- 6 further overwhelm local facilities

At the same time

- 7 no further schools, retail or local roads will be added despite them being totally full
- 8 no extra crossings of either the Bridgewater or Manchester ship canal will be added

- 10 there will be little or no benefit to the commercial centre of Warrington . The people who but the houses will sleep in the area but look outwards for their spending. - 11 ecologically this will be a disaster for the local flora and fauna
