



The local plan is not sound and is simply unfit for purpose for the following reasons:

- 1/ The local plan is not in line with Government policy, particularly in respect to Governments own targets for new housing per year and Government guidance on using brown belt land wherever possible. The release of Green Belt land for development can only be justified in exceptional circumstances. WBC have failed to demonstrate that there are exceptional circumstances.
- 2/ WBC has failed to demonstrate the the local plan is based on an objective and independent needs assessment. The local plan makes no solid provision for the delivery of the road, schools and medical infrastructure required to sustain the increase population numbers that would arise as a result such a large scale development.
- 3/ WBC has a history of failing to deliver and operate complex, large scale developments to time and budget e.g. Hubs in districts
- 4/ WBC has failed to undertake an assessment of the environmental impact of the local plan in terms of increase in pollution, congestion and loss of green space and the diverse village communities that exist within the area impacted by the local plan.
