I would like to submit my strongest objection to the development plan for Warrington South.

The plan is unsound and undeliverable. It is being rushed through with the recent timescales of the Fiddlers ferry closure not being taken into account. This incredible number of houses and commercial units proposed in the area will destroy the precious local countryside and certain wildlife for ever.

Some of the commercial units will be the biggest in the north west bringing with it a huge number of commercial vehicles further adding to the congestion and pollution. Warrington already has poor record regarding air quality and noise.

The number of houses proposed in the scheme is simply obscene. Our town and villages are already at grid lock throughout the day.
